**THE KINGS HEAD, Tealby, Lincolnshire**

*The Kings Head Tealby, is believed to be the oldest thatched pub in Lincolnshire, dating from around 1367. It is located at the edge of the Lincolnshire Wolds, along two popular walking and cycling trails: the Viking Way and the Lindsey Trail. This whitewashed inn has outdoor seating and a beer garden containing antique farm equipment. The well-kept village is home to many charming historic buildings.*

## THE BELL INN, Stilton, Cambridgeshire

Dating back to the 15th century, the Bell Inn is one of the oldest and most famous of the former coaching inns on England's historic Great North Road. The inn was renowned for its very large ornate hanging sign, which projected out into the road, and for its reputation as the place to get the best of a locally distinctive and much sought-after cheese that became known throughout England as Stilton.

## CROSS KEYS INN, Cautley, Sedbergh, Cumbria

A popular refreshment place for walkers near the fine Cautley Spout waterfall, the inn's origins go back 400 years when it was owned by a local Quaker. In 1652, a speech given by George Fox from a nearby fell, attended by over 1,000 people, led to the founding of the Quaker movement. It has been a temperance inn since 1902 and was left to the National Trust with the proviso that it should not sell alcohol.

## THE ARTILLERY ARMS, Bunhill Row, London

This Victorian pub, dating from the 1850s, has a dark woody interior, stained glass and high shelving. It gets its name from the Honourable Artillery Company, whose barracks have been nearby since the 17th century. It is situated at the edge of the City of London opposite Bunhill Fields Burial Ground, resting place of British 'non-conformist' poets John Milton and William Blake, and writer Daniel Defoe.

### THE HARBOUR INN, Axmouth, Devon

Set on Church Street in the lovely estuary village of Axmouth, near the famous Jurassic Coast, this pretty thatched inn dates from the 12th century. The Grade II-listed country pub features a large open-stone fireplace, with a popular beer garden outside. Axmouth was once one of the most important harbours on the south-west coast until the 14th century. It is now mostly used by yachts and smaller boats.

## THREE DAWES, Gravesend, Kent

Standing at the river edge, this white wooden waterside pub has welcomed sailors and river men of all nationalities since 1565. Large sailing merchant ships would anchor off the Three Daws while awaiting supplies and a fair wind, or on returning from long overseas voyages. Just one of many waterfront taverns on the Thames, it was the haunt of smugglers and was regularly raided by the naval press gangs.

**PRINCE LLEWELYN, Beddgelert, Gwynedd**

*This striking hotel, built in local stone, dates from the mid-1830s and stands beneath a rocky outcrop in Beddgelert, in Snowdonia. In 1949, a most unusual event occurred when the hotel was hit by a meteorite, making a jagged hole in the roof. At the junction of two rivers, Beddgelert has a famous monument at the legendary grave of 'Gelert', the faithful hound of the medieval Prince Llewelyn the Great.*

## THE BLUE PETER INN, Polperro, Cornwall

Once frequented by fishermen and smugglers, this quaint 18th century pub is nestled between ancient cottages on the harbour and Fish Quay, in the scenic fishing village of Polperro. Its name comes from the maritime signal flag 'Blue Peter', which indicates a ship's readiness to set sail. 'The Blue' is on two levels, with wooden floors, low beams, nooks and crannies, and a view of the sea and harbour.

### WHITE HORSE, Holme-next-the-Sea, Norfolk

Situated in the appealing village of Holme-next-the-Sea, near Hunstanton, this cosy Grade II-listed pub, with low ceilings and an inglenook fireplace, offers a warm welcome to locals, coastal walkers and visitors. Between the village and the sea is a thin strip of salt marsh, much used by migratory birds, and there are several nature reserves nearby along this stunning stretch of the North Norfolk Coast.

## THE OLD MILL INN, Pitlochry, Perth and Kinross

This stone-built country pub in the town centre, with a sunny beer garden, is a former 18th century gristmill and still has a working waterwheel. Pitlochry is set amidst mountains including Ben Vrackie (840m). The famous Pitlochry Dam across the River Tummel, and the Fish ladder built to allow salmon to swim upstream to spawn, as well as the Blair Athol Distillery founded in 1798, are its main attractions.

## THE WHITE HART, Hart Village, Co. Durham

This cosy pub is noted for the ship's figurehead on its exterior, a replica of the original, salvaged from a barque called *The Rising Sun*, shipwrecked at Hartlepool during a great storm in 1861. On the brick walls of the bar are nautical knotted rope displays. The small village, surrounded by rolling limestone countryside, has a beautiful Saxon church of St Mary Magdalene and fine views out to sea.

## CORNER CUPBOARD INN, Winchcombe, Glouc.

*This striking 16th century pub, built of Cotswold stone with an inglenook fireplace and stone-flagged floor, stands in the delightful village of Winchcombe. It was a farmhouse until 1872 and the name may come from the fact that almost every corner in the house had a cupboard. It still has two 16th century corner cupboards in the bar. There is a bust of Victorian Prime Minister Disraeli over the door.*
