CALEDONIA



This former fishing port with a tranquil harbour encircled by attractive houses is a popular east coast resort. The wide curving shingle beach is backed by cliffs. Near the harbour stands the 16th century tollbooth, the town's oldest building, now an intriguing museum. There are panoramic views from the war memorial set on a hill above the town. Further south along the coast is Dunnottar Castle, a huge ruined fortress, set on a sheer cliff.

CALEDONIA

Originally built as a grand residential square, laid out in 1781, George Square has developed into Glasgow's principal civic space. With its collection of monuments and statues of significant public figures, it is overlooked by the splendid City Chambers. Crowned by its towers and cupolas, it was built in 1888 on the wealth of colonial trade and industry to reflect commercial pride. Mosaic ceilings and murals inside depict civic history.

RING OF BRODGAR STONE CIRCLE
ORKNEY ISLANDS

CALEDONIA

This ceremonial site dating from 2500-2000 BC lies within a natural amphitheatre of hills. It includes a massive stone circle of 27 stones (originally 60), between 2.1m and 4.7m high, surrounded by a rock-cut ditch and 13 prehistoric burial mounds. It is the only major henge and stone circle in Britain that is an almost perfect circle, and stands on a narrow isthmus between two lochs. The ring of stones is very large - 103.7m in diameter.

BEN NEVIS AND LOCH EILCH HIGHLAND

CALEDONIA

Reflected in Loch Eil, a sea loch opening into Loch Linnhe, Ben Nevis is Britain's highest mountain, 1,345m in height. It attracts around 100,000 walkers a year, ascending from Glen Nevis on the south side. On the north face, the 600m-high cliffs are a magnet for experienced climbers and mountaineers. Frequently shrouded by mist, the summit is the collapsed dome of an ancient volcano, with the remains of an observatory, used from 1883-1904.

NOSS HEAD LIGHTHOUSE
CAITHNESS, HIGHLAND

CALEDONIA

Close to the fishing town of Wick, on a small headland overlooking Sinclairs Bay, Noss Head Lighthouse first started service in 1849. It was automated in 1987 and the former keepers' cottages have been converted to holiday cottages. Its white 18m-high tower is visible for miles across the flat cliff-top landscape. Puffins and other seabirds can be seen near the lighthouse and the sea area off Noss Head is a designated Marine Protection Area.

Snow covers a small fishing boat drawn up on the shoreline of this remote and tranquil loch, the largest natural loch in the Borders. Sheltered by steep hills with fine views of the surrounding peaks and the Yarrow Valley, St Mary's Loch is situated near Ettrick Forest, once a royal hunting ground. Popular with walkers, cyclists and anglers, it lies on the Southern Upland Way and is linked to the smaller Loch of the Lowes by a narrow channel.
